I. Narrative Section – 50 % of grade

Category for Narrative Section	Unacceptable	Acceptable	Exemplary
Background Information on the Student	Narrative includes only two or three items of information on the student, which do not show knowledge or understanding of the student. 10 points	Narrative includes 4 or five items of information on the student that show understanding and incite about the student. 20 points	Narrative includes 6 or more items of information about the student that show understanding and respect for the student as well as positive teacher-student interaction. 30 points
Eligibility Conclusions	Narrative demonstrates incorrect conclusions regarding the student's eligibility status. 15 points	Narrative shows correct conclusions regarding the student's eligibility status. 30 points	Narrative shows correct conclusions regarding the eligibility status. Narrative shows incite regarding possible reasons for performance and makes recommendations for further testing. 45 points
Educational Recommendations	Narrative section does not include adequate discussion of the results of the SSQ or the LSI nor appropriate educational recommendations. 25 points	Narrative section includes discussion of the results of the SSQ and the LSI and discusses one or two educational recommendations. 50 points	Narrative section includes discussion of the results of the SSQ and the LSI and discusses educationally appropriate recommendations. Also includes how classroom instruction could utilize these results for student learning. 75 points

Background information on student includes basic information about the student, student's family, personality/behavior in class, peer relationships, etc.

Eligibility conclusions based on gifted criteria- The narrative should discuss why the student did or did not qualify for gifted placement and should include all four categories.

Educational recommendations based on all data collected -Use the personality profile (SSQ) and discuss profile type characteristics, classroom applications, classroom environment, positive reinforcement, & tests. Also, use the LSI and discuss learning preferences indicated by the student (ex. projects, teaching games, discussion).
